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Introduction

Already 11 years ago we made our first trip to Borneo. Since then, a lot has changed, especially post-covid some previously mythical species have become accessible in hides (Bulwer's Pheasant and Bornean Peacock Pheasant) and Sarawak is more easily visited. The first week we visited Sarawak (Ba'kelalan and Paya Maga) and the second week several places in Sabah (Klias, Trus Madi hide, BPP hide, Mount Kinabalu).

Some thoughts about our itinerary

- The Sarawak and Sabah parts couldn't be more different. The two sites in Sarawak are along a muddy road with very limited infrastructure (in ways of getting diesel or a mechanic to fix your car (..), with Sabah being very well organised, good roads and most smaller towns having everything you need on a birding trip.
- Borneo is a popular destination and July is a popular month for birdwatching. We planned this trip very last
 minute (1,5 month in advance) and thus decided to maximize our flexibility and drive everything ourselves.
 We had to shuffle around a few sites due to availability of hides, so it's best to start planning in earlier (for
 example the Trus Madi Jungle Camp was fully booked at the time we wanted to visit so we skipped that). We
 tried to take known birding tours into account (to avoid) which did not fully work.

Species we wanted to see and thought to be possible this trip but missed:

- Hose's Broadbill: possible in Paya Maga and Ba'kelalan but we didn't find it at both sites, also possible along the road between Paya Maga. Finding a fruiting tree is probably the best chance since we expect the response to tape to be minimal in the peak birding season.
- Jambu Fruitdove: there had been a few sightings in Klias so we hoped to find this elusive fruit dove but sadly we couldn't find any.

Given that this was our second trip to Sabah we focused on specific targets/ species that were new for us. Therefore, we did not search for some of the Borneo endemics (for example Whitehead's Broadbill).

What would we do different in hindsight

Driving back-and-forth to Ba'kelalan is not ideal, it is a long and bumpy drive and with prolonged rains the road can deteriorate quite badly. The solution most people chose is to arrange for a one-way transport and fly out. (e.g. see Van der Schoor) which is a more convenient option. In that case a small car is perfectly fine for the rest of the itinerary in Sabah. For driving to Paya Maga/Ba'kelan and birding at those sites a 4WD is necessary.

Other birders

Borneo is a very popular destination in the summer months, and we encountered many other birders and photographers especially in Kinabalu but we met birders/photographers at all sites and a French family we met at Klias, Ba'kelan, Paya Maga and Kinabalu (!).

Practicalities

Guiding

We did not use any guides except for a morning session to find the Dulit Frogmouth in Ba'kelalan with Sang and we pre-arranged the visit to the 2 hides (Trus Madi hide for Bulwer's Pheasant and BPP hide)

Literature

We took the Birds of Borneo (Susan Myers) digitally on our phones, used Merlin and downloaded additional recordings from xeno-canto.org. We relied on tripreports found on www.cloudbirders.com especially those of Van den Schoor 2023, Drukker 2023, Lebrun 2018.

Essential reading is: **BirdingASIA** 40 (2023): 27–39 **Citizen science and** *dodgei* **records: revisiting the identification and distribution of Bornean Swiftlet** by James Eaton & Alex Berryman.

Travelling

Since we decided to drive the Sarawak parts ourselves we rented a Toyota Hilux through Rentalcars.com with KK Rent A Car (for 1179 euro for the full trip). They did not have an airport office but we were awaited at the airport and handed over the car. On our drive towarsd Ba'kelalan the car lost power on higher revs, which made the driving somewhat more complicated. We decided to drive onwards. We asked Sang if there was a mechanic in the village who

could take a look but sadly there wasn't. We ended up driving the car back to asphalt with the lack of power at the end of our birding and got the issue fixed in Beaufort. It turned out some pipe between the compressor and engine had burst and it needed a spare part which had been a problem even if the right part had been identified earlier. We burned through our diesel quicker as well due to this issue, luckily Sang could help us with that, from personal storage, there is no diesel for sale along the route. So if you decide to drive yourself, to be safe it would be best to bring a jerrycan along (although probably with some persistence and money there is always ways to get some more diesel).

Eating & Sleeping

- Ba'kelalan: Julia's Homestay the best option in town. Contact Sang/Julia through Whatsapp: +60 178729673),
- Paya Maga: Merarap resort copying previous visitors we contacted them through Whatsapp (+60
 173427558) and booked a stay. The downside is that the resort is a 4k very steep drive down to the river. It
 turned out well for us. As an alternative that might be worth exploring: just beyond the road to Paya Maga
 we saw: MENANGANG PLACE, which is closer to Paya Maga and seems closer to the road and possibly a
 better location. Tommy (one of the owners of Merarap) can also assist with transport for the whole trip and
 not sure if Menangang Place can organize similar arrangments. Another good option would the homestay
 (Tian Cool Homestay on google) on the beginning of track be, probably another way to arrange a
 cabin stay as well these details were not on google before our trip)
- Klias: The Gem Hotel in Beaufort fine option
- Tambunan: Padi View Resthouse fine
- Telupid: D'Village Hotel basic but other options were already full and this was the third option we tried.
- Kinabalu: Lily Cottage & Kitchen booked through Booking.com lot's of options around Kinabalu NP this was fine and had the extra benefit of a Bornean Island Thrush that had turned up in the garden.

Weather

We had some showers in the first days (mainly at night), which wasn't helpful for the road in Sarawak but didn't hamper birding. Our second afternoon in Kinabalu we had a heavy shower. July is usually a drier month, but with global weather patterns getting less reliable you just have to be somewhat lucky.

Health and safety

Nothing out of the ordinary (take care in traffic and have some insect repellent around)

Money

ATM's were widespread in Sabah, but it is best to bring cash for the Sarawak part of Paya Maga/Ba'kelalan.

Visited Sites

We took a few GPS points of sites, those are available here

We made another google map with GPS-points gathered beforehand, send us an email If you are interested is in this file. All bird sightings were recorded with GPS-location with a file available if you are interested as well.

Klias

Logistics

The site is a short drive from Beaufort with accommodation/supermarket/restaurants etc. so we saw no use in staying at the site where there is accommodation (which is possible but cheap and kind of crappy). The gate was open the whole time we were there so we could come and go as we liked and pay the entrance fees when the office was open.

Birding

We birded a short morning here on our first day and then came back after Sarawak for a longer visit of one afternoon and another morning. We spent most time on the far side of the triangle (around 5.3218, 115.6607) as we had seen that most sightings were there of the flowerpecker and bulbul. It took quite a while but we saw all of the targets in this area (the Scarlet-breasted Flowerpecker took the most time but eventually we saw a beautiful male).

One evening we birded the far side of the triangle and searched for owls on the way back which was very successful.

Target birds

Hook-billed Bulbul, Scarlet-breasted Flowerpecker, Brown-backed Flowerpecker. Owls (Oriental Bay, Reddish Scops, Sunda Scops, Brown Boobook)

Ba'kelalan

Logistics

As most birders and tour groups we stayed at Julia Homestay. It is a perfect basis to explore the region with simple rooms (shared bathrooms) and excellent food. We parked at 3.9753, 115.6187 and walk the rest (you can't drive all the way to the Homestay).

Birding

We birded mainly along the road to Bario. The road is quite steep and terribly muddy in wet conditions. There are only a few vehicles a day so walking and birding along the road is fine. Since the road is quite steep there is quite a difference in birds lower along the road (chance for Hose's Broadbill) and higher (Whiteheads Broadbill possible). Since our car was not properly working on both full days we parked at the beginning and walked from there up and down the road.

Target birds

Crocker Range Jungle Flycatcher is sometimes seen at the top of the road but unfortunately we couldn't visit this part due to our car not functioning. We missed Hose's Broadbill. In general the birding felt a bit slow and after talking to Sang it seems that bird activity is declining along the road due to intensity of taping/visiting birders? We did enjoy our time here however. For example one corner of the road held Bornean Banded Pitta, Blue-banded Pitta and Rail-babbler (around 3.9441, 115.5952). Dulit Frogmouth was seen on the first morning with Sang (he knows where the territories are and which birds have been active in the last weeks). We started at 4AM and followed him through a maze of fields and small tracks. After trying for a while the bird flew in silently (which Rob luckily saw from the corner of his eye) and then gave excellent views.

Paya Maga

Logistics

We stayed at Merarap Hotspring resort which is half an hour drive of the birding site. The first part of the road is still along some small houses. You can drive until 4.43822,115.5083 and from there bird along the trail (both days we parked a bit before and birded the last 400m of the road which already has some better forest. There is not an entrance sign and in the end we met the local ranger on the trail (he was with another guide and the French family at the cabin) where we payed him the entrance fee of 10 ringit per person per day.

Birding

On the first day we slowly bird up and a bit beyond the cabin (4.4395, 115.5376). A pair of Black Oriole is quickly found in the clearing (4.4405, 115.5394). We have our packed lunch around 4.4406,115.5419 and afterwards bird down again. One of the highlights at the end of the day is a beautiful Blue-banded Pitta that we see very well after stalking a singing bird at 4.4368, 115.5192. The second day we walked and birded up again. When we meet the Ornis birding group just below the cabin we let them pass towards the higher part of the trail and we turn around and focus more on the lower part of the trail. In general it is a beautiful trail to bird (especially if you have it all to yourself), however we were a bit disappointed when after 2 full days with did not see or hear a Hose's Broadbill which became our big miss of the trip.

Target birds

Hose Broadbill, Black Oriole, Blue-banded Pitta

Crocker Range

Logistics

We stayed 2 nights at Tambunan. From there the Crocker Range is easily reached.

Birding

On our first afternoon we (arriving from Klias) we birded the lower area of forest along the busy road at a rest stop and a corner (5.7665, 116.3421). Bird activity was high and we stayed until dusk. The next morning we start again at the corner for the first hour of birding and then drove further up to the Gunung Alab road (starts at 5.8125, 116.3381). This is a quieter side road which leads up to a communication tower and a small feeding station. The weather was very grey with some light rain and bird activity was therefore a bit slow. After lunch along the main road we walk and bird up to the antennas again. At the feeding station we say a nice group of Red-breasted and Crimson-headed Partridges that often visits the feeder here. Last stop of the day is at "the corner" lower down the road again. Helen finds a White-heads Spiderhunter but unfortunately flies of very quickly with only a brief view for Rob.

Target birds

Whiteheads Spiderhunter (Helen only), Crimson-headed and Red-breasted Partridge at feeding station

Trus Madi (Tambunan entrance/Bulwer's hide)

Logistics

The hide is easily reached along a well-paved asphalt road (hide location 5.6078,116.4500). We contacted the hide owner at +60 178989778 and arranged our visit. (Other option would be to visit Trus Madi Jungle Camp which was full at the time we wanted to visit.) When we arrived at 6am it turned out to be an enormous and luxurious hide that can have many visitors and comes with a toilet, kitchen, etc. We paid 550 ringit per person, not cheap but one of the only ways to see the mythical Bulwer's Pheasant.

Birding

Sit in the hide and wait which is quite enjoyable because of the wide range of species visiting (Bornean Banded Pitta, Crested Partridge, etc). Before it was fully light we had a male Bulwer's Pheasant quickly walking past which did not show again. Later we did see some females. (Other birders that turned up later that morning said this was there second try and after 15hours of waiting they were very happy with only seeing females) so it felt we were lucky. At 3pm we left the hide to continue our journey towards Telupid.

Target birds

Bulwer's pheasant, Bornean Banded Pitta, Crested Partridge. In hindsight we should have come earlier to search for Bornean Frogmouth which is sometimes found along the main road towards the hide.

Telupid (BPP hide)

Logistics

We contacted Khairul (+60 12 8445561 whatsapp). We stayed in Telupid the night before and met Khairul at the road side restaurant (5.6621, 117.0482) at 6AM where we had breakfast and the possibility to bring a packed lunch. We then continued onwards to village where we hopped in the back of two pick-ups (together with a Swiss independent birder and Thai group) drove for a bit and then walked up to the hide (5.634, 117.0100).

Birding

Sit in the hide and wait for the star of the show, the Bornean Peacock Pheasant to appear. There were not too many other species around but a calling Helmeted Hornbill was nice.

Target birds

Bornean Peackock-Pheasant was heard on the walk up to the hide. After we settled in the male circled us (showing shortly through the side of the hide) until he came out on the feeding area at 08.30, which he repeated for a couple of times until we left the area at 12.00.

Mount Kinabalu

Logistics

There is lots of accommodation outside the park and some inside the park as well. We stayed outside the park and parked our car outside the park. Apparently it's possible to get a birders permit but we liked the walking so didn't go for the permit.

Birding

Since we had been to Mount Kinabalu before we focused on the species we missed the previous visit. The easiest birding is along the main road up the mountain which sometimes is a bit busy with cars but in our experience still quite nice to bird. On our first afternoon we birded up till the stretch which is good for Everetts thrush and found a Fruithunter (6.0195, 116.5409) lower down. The next morning we walked up again and found Everetts Thrush (2 birds at 6.0253, 116.5469). After showing the birds to a few birders they tell us they had seen Island Thrush lower down the mountain which we try but cannot find. We continue up the road and while taking a rest we found another Fruithunter just below Timphon gate. On eBird we had seen a sighting of Island thrush in the garden of our resort so we tried that successfully in the afternoon. The next morning walking up the road we found a Whiteheads Spiderhunter that showed very well (6.0188, 116.5369). Overall we birded some trails (quite a few of them were closed off) but had the best results along the road.

Target birds

Fruithunter, Whiteheads Spiderhunter, Everett's Thrush, Bornean Island Thrush

Kota Belud ricefields & Taman Prince Phillip Park

Logistics

On our way back from Mount Kinabalu to the airport we birded around the Kota Belud Ricefields for a bit and walked around the park between the airport and the sea.

Birding

Kota Belud: drive around area and find the rice fields with water and not yet overgrown in area (6.3872,116.4564)

Taman Prince Phillip Park: We parked at 5.9469,116.0472 and walked around park. Not the most exciting area but a good options for an hour of birding before a flight. Another option in Kota Kinabalu is the Tun Fuad Stephan's Park (5.9475, 116.1084) where Scops owl and Sunda Frogmouth are possible but we didn't feel up to it on our first night in Kota Kinabalu.

Target birds

Kota Belud: We had two targets being Black-backed Swamphen and Watercock: we only found the Black-backed Swamphen but had quite a few year ticks and Greater Painted-snipe was nice.

Taman Prince Phillip Park: Sunda Pygmy Woodpecker and Pied Triller where new for us and easily found

ANNOTATED SPECIES LIST

We have tried to accurately indicate the proper subspecies for all our observations, usually based on geographic locations based on the IOC World Bird List. We tried to keep detailed notes throughout the trip but especially commoner species might not have been written down daily. Triplist generated with iGoterra, see www.igoterra.com for details.
